MDRO including MRSA

1. Hard-to-treat bacteria

- Do you have a bacterial infection that cannot be effectively treated with antibiotics? (e.g., MRSA)



2. Care abroad (last 12 months)

Have you been in a hospital or care centre abroad in the last twelve months, and did you:

- have an operation or surgery where something was placed in your body (e.g., a tube or drain)?
- develop an infection or skin problems (e.g., abscesses, pimples, or other skin problems)?



3. Short stay in hospital or care centre abroad (last 2 months)

Have you been admitted to a hospital or care centre abroad for less than 24 hours with any of the above problems in the last two months?



4. Recent risks in the Netherlands (last 2 months)

In the past two months, have you:

- stayed in a hospital or care centre where MDRO/MRSA is present?
- lived in a refugee shelter?



5. Contact with livestock (last 2 months)

Have you been in contact with commercially kept live animals, such as:

- pigs?
- veal calves?
- broiler chickens?

Or do you live on a farm where these animals are present?



6. Contact with an MRSA-positive person

Are you a household member, partner, or caregiver of someone who is MRSA positive?
